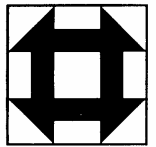

HALL COUNTY QUILT GUILD MINUTES

FOR MARCH 5, 2007

The meeting was called to order at 10:01 by Co. President Ginny Hendrix. Guest speaker, Marge LaBenne was introduced. She gave a most interesting lecture entitled KISS – Keep it Simply Squares. Samples of these charity quilts were shown and many interesting suggestions were made regarding piecing and quilting.

The minutes of the HCQG for the February 5th meeting were published in the last newsletter by Trixie Comfort., secretary. The minutes were approved by all present. There were 31 members present, one new member and one guest. Committee reports were called for by Co-President, Nancy Folsom. Myra Taylor reported that she has compiled a book listing all books in our library. Basting day will be March 19th with no quilts to be basted but it was suggested that member do come to work on one of their projects and for fellowship. A thank you was issued for those who brought refreshments. Hospitality: Myra Taylor needs more sign ups for refreshments for coming months. The sign up sheet was passed around to the group. Sunshine: Eliza Cagle reported that life time member Suzy Lee, age 88 is home bound and cards would be appreciated sent by guild members. She also reported that former member Sandy Myers has had shoulder surgery and is presently in rehab. Linda Sells, a member's husband is recovering from a stroke. Eagle Ranch: Jean Leslie reported that Richard Hood has brought 3 quilted Eagle Ranch quilts that need to be taken by the members that made them to be bound. Spring 2007 Quilt Show: Linda O'Donnell reported that HCQG raffle quilt will be at the Spring Chicken Festival on April 28 from 8 AM to 5 PM and she has printed tickets on her computer. Our quilts will be shown at the Administration Building located across from the Mountain Center and the theme is: One Quarter Mile of Quilting. Tickets printed by Linda were available for members to sell. Members were reminded to register quilts they plan to have in the show if quilts from our Oct. show will be in this one, the information forms need to be included with the quilts. Additional quilts need to register sizes and numbers given. Quilts are to be brought to the April meeting. Our 2007 raffle quilt will be at the Ga. Quilt Council Convention this month and tickets will be sold. Treasurer: Barbara Wyatt passed out proposed budget information for 2007 and the budget was approved by all present.

Break at 10:50. Reconvened at 11:01. The program for April will be by Jayne Buckwalter which will be on Civil War Quilts. The May program will be done by Debby Kratovil and the class will be Dogwood Blossoms. Glenda Holcomb reminded members of the sailboat fabric available to make placemats and a napkin for the June picnic at Sunrise Cove. Block of the Month patterns were passed out to those who signed up at a cost of \$5 for the year. She also discussed Socks Blocks which will be swap and members interested in the swap signed up. Sign ups will continue through the May meeting. Julie Monroe reminded members of the Ga. Quilt Council convention on March 17 and thanked members for bringing spring flower fat quarters for the donation basket for door prizes at the convention. The regular basket door prize was won by Pat Graham.

Meeting was adjourned at 11:55. Following lunch Marge LaBenne instructed a class on Quilts for Special People. Each member chose one pattern to work on at the workshop and was given 3 additional patterns.

Block Size: 7" Number of Blocks in Quilt: 12 Quilt Size: 31-1/2" x 38-1/2"

You can use any colors you desire; the following is a guide for colors

Materials You Will Need...

- Fat 1/8 EACH of: pink, purple, magenta, yellow, green and blue bright fabrics
- 1/2 yard fabric for background of block points (my quilt uses butterscotch)
- 1/4 yard EACH of two multi-print fabrics for block background (mine is floral)
- 1/4 yard hot pink for inner border
- 1/2 yard blue dot for outer border
- 1/3 yard stripe for binding
- Paper for foundation patterns
- 36" x 43" piece of thin batting
- 1 yard backing

I will supply 1 master pattern and 2-3 printed paper foundations for working in class. Students can use the master patterns to photocopy at a later date or purchase a set from me.

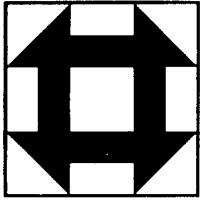
Pre-cutting strips for paper piecing the arcs

- For each arc cut :
 - (6) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" background fabric (butterscotch) - total of 72 wedges
 - (5) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" in desired colors for the points - total of 60 wedges

Pre-cutting units for curved base and background unit

- (12) 4-1/2" squares for curved base (1/4 circle)
- (2) 7-1/2" x 42" strips of floral (or other) background. We will use my template to recut these

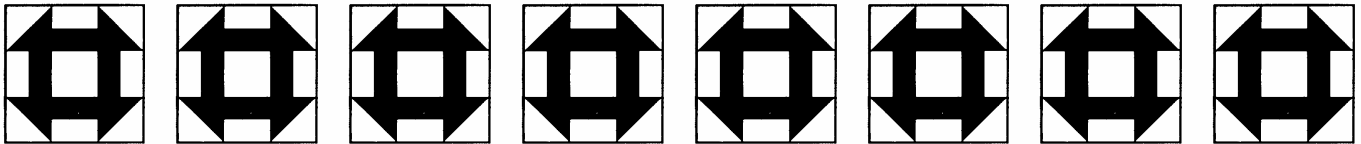
