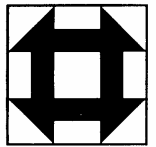

LOCKER HOOKING WORKSHOP

The locker hooking workshop will take place from 12 noon to 3pm, on August 6th. This technique uses up a tremendous amount of those scraps and ugly prints. Plus it is a lot of fun.

The supplies are a locker hook (looks like a crochet hoot with a needle eye on the end).

Locker hook twine

Cutting mat and rotary cutter, & fabric

Tapestry needle, blunt end #13

Canvas will be provided.

Our goal is to sell \$4,000 in raffle tickets...and, if each guild member sells only \$75.00 in raffle tickets, we will reach our goal! HALL COUNTY QUILT GUILD MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 AM by Co-President Nancy Folsom. A correction to the June minutes was made by Jean Leslie. The additional \$10 approved by members present at the June picnic includes two chairs and two tables' not just chairs as listed in the June minutes. Carol Nation reported that 21 members were in attendance with one new member joining. Charlotte Baxter. The Treasurers report published in the newsletter was accepted. A motion was made and seconded to skip basting day in July since there are no quilts to be basted. Martha Griffin showed a quilt frame that was given to the guild large enough to baste a twin sized quilt and reminded the group that there is a large frame in the church attic. Sunshine Chair woman, Eliza Cagle reported that Suzy Lee is not doing well in the health department but was able to enjoy her 64th wedding anniversary at the Red Lobster. Her daughter died in March. Suzy donated some books to the guild and various kinds of thread. Some sort of thank you needs to be made to Suzy. Linda O'Donnell's dad has taken a fall and broke his hip. Jean Leslie, Eagle Ranch chair woman said there soon will be 17 new children at Eagle Ranch and as a result Jenny took 25 quilts to Eagle Ranch. There is going to be a need for more of these quilts and members were asked to continue making them. Jean is putting together fabric in baggies for Blocks for Eagle Ranch and members can take and make one block or 4 blocks. Members can put their name in a special prize bag based on the number of blocks made. Under New Business Jean also asked if the guild would like to be involved in the Hoschton Fall Festival to show our raffle quilt and sell tickets but it was decided not to be involved with this since we will be busy September 29 at the Gainesville Art on the Square event. The raffle quilt was taken by Fay Rawls to Athens and will be taken in September to Mountain Laurel Quilt Guild by Pat Anderson and Sylvia Hulsey. We need someone from the Gwinnett Guild to take it in October and sell tickets. Jean will contact Sew Memorable about hanging the quilt and selling tickets. A committee is needed to set up rules for the boutique at the Art on the Square Festival. Refreshments were provided by Jackie Rochester, Joan Garland, Joan Briggs, Julie Monroe and Ginny Hendrix and were enjoyed by the group. August refreshments will be provided by Karen Shoda, Myra Taylor, Charlotte Baxter and Nancy Folsom. Because fabric is discounted at 40% at the Quilted Hearts Going out of Business Sale Jean Leslie, Julie Monroe, Charlotte Baxter and Nancy Folsom planned to go on July 3 at 1:00 PM to look for fabric for the 2008 raffle quilt. Julie has a possible pattern to use. The main door prize was won by Fay Rawls and there were several birthday door prize bags as well. A sign up list for the Locker Hooking class offered by Linda O'Donnell at the August meeting was passed through the group and we were told that a kit is available for sale at Hobby Lobby Stores at about \$7.00 each. Show and Tell: approximately 7 quilts were shown. The meeting adjourned at 10:55. Following the meeting Shirley Erickson taught a delightful class on crayon quilts complete with a lesson on how to shade so the finished piece does not look flat.

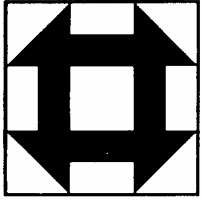

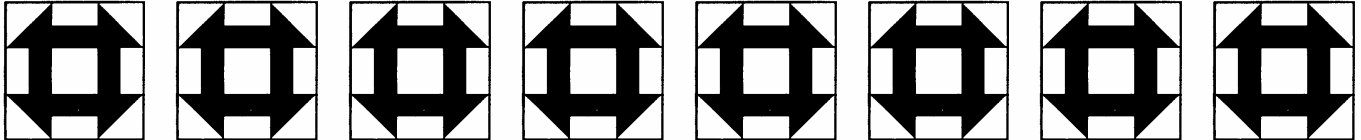
