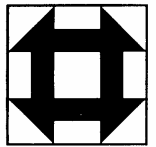

**CAN OF WORMS**

Hi Ladies and Richard,

I want to take this time and thank everyone for participating in the swap. Please keep the following information as a referral when swapping fabric for the worms.

1. Choose one fabric
2. Required amount of fabric is one and one-fourth of a yard.
3. 100% quilt shop quality fabrics please.
4. Wash and iron
5. Cut the salvage off and then the folded edge.
6. Then you cut your strips.
7. Swap only the months that you want too.
8. If you miss a month just pick back up the next month.
9. You can submit strips for future months in advance if you know that you will not be at a meeting. But no make-ups.

DECEMBER—Purple—2 inches—40 strips

JANUARY—Ecru—3 inches—30 strips

FEBRUARY—Pink—3 ¼ inches—26 strips

MARCH—Orange—3 ¼ inches—26 strips

Please only send the amount of strips requested.

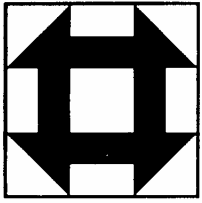

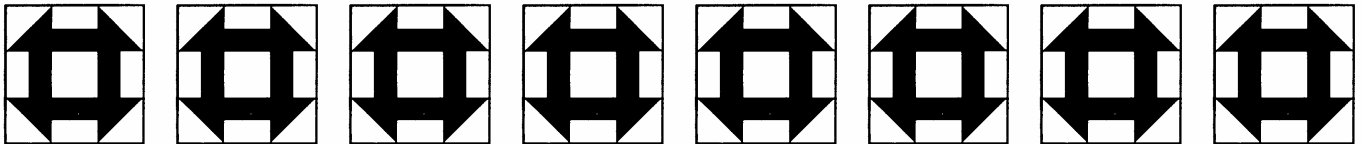
