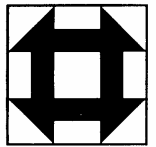

Recipes from 2006

WALDORF SALAD – Pat Anderson

4 medium Apples, cored and chopped 3 cups (I used Red Delicious)
 ½ cup chopped Celery
 ½ cup red seedless Grapes, halved (I also used green seedless Grapes)

½ cup chopped Walnuts
 Romaine lettuce to line salad container
 ½ cup Mayonnaise or Salad Dressing
 1 Tbs. Sugar
 ½ tsp Lemon Juice
 ½ cup Whipping Cream

Combine apples, celery, grapes and walnuts. Turn fruit into a romaine lined salad bowl. Chill. Combine mayonnaise, sugar and lemon juice mixture. Spoon the dressing over the chilled apple mixture and keep cold until serving. Fold dressing into fruit mixtures. Makes 6-8 servings. This recipe may be doubled or tripled.

COCONUT CREAM CAKE – Sylvia Hulsey

1 box White Cake Cake
 1 can Eagle Brand Condensed Milk

1 can Cream of Coconut
 1 small carton Cool Whip
 1 small can Angel Flake Coconut

Bake cake as directed on box. Bake in a 9X13 pan. When done punch holes in the cake. Mix Condensed milk and Cream of Coconut together and pour over hot cake. Let cake cool. Spread cool whip over cake. Sprinkle coconut over cool whip. Refrigerate overnight before serving.

KEY LIME CAKE – Trixie Comfort

1 ½ cup Sugar	2 Cups Plain Flour
½ tsp Salt	½ tsp Baking Soda
1 tsp Baking Powder	1-3 oz. Pkg. Lime Gelatin
5 Eggs	1 ½ cups Oil
¾ cup Orange Juice	½ tsp Vanilla
1 tsp Lemon Extract	⅓ cup Lime juice
⅓ cup 4X Confectioners Sugar	

Blend sugar, flour, salt, baking soda and powder, gelatin eggs, oil orange juice and extracts at low speed until moist. Beat 2 to 4 minutes at medium speed. Pour into 3 greased pans. Bake 30 to 40 minutes at medium speed. Pour into 3 greased pans. Bake 30 to 40 minutes at 350. Mix lime juice with confectioners sugar, prick cake with fork to allow mixture to soak in and pour over warm cake layers. Frost with Cream Cheese Frosting.

CREAM CHEESE FROSTING.

Mix altogether.

2 sticks of Butter
2 tsp. Vanilla
2-8 oz pkgs Cream Cheese, softened
2 Boxes Powdered Sugar
1 Cup Chopped Pecans

CRANBERRY APPLE CASSEROLE – Fran Dadisman

In greased casserole mix	
3 cups diced unpeeled apples	1/2 cup brown sugar
2 cups raw cranberries	1/3 cup flour
1 cup sugar	1/3 chopped nuts
Top with mixture of	1/2 melted butter
1 1/2 cups oatmeal	

Bake for 1hr or until fruit is well done. I bake covered for 1hr, uncover continue baking for app. 15 minutes

STRUDEL – Amanda Whitsel

1 box of hot roll mix : mix according to the pizza dough directions on the box
marinara or pizza sauce

One was filled with browned hamburger, mozzarella cheese and seasoned with basil .

the other was combination of sautéed bell pepper and asparagus combined with canned mushrooms and black olives and mozzarella cheese and oregano.

The meat filling will do better if it's cool. If it's hot the dough gets gooey. The vegetable mix does better if the excess water is squeezed out.

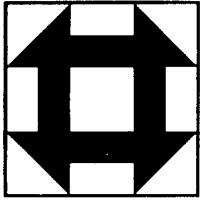
Roll out half the dough for each in a long oval . Make sure it's not stuck to the surface so you can pick up the loaf .

Spread some kind of pizza or marinara sauce down the center. Place filling on top. Make diagonal slashes in the dough up each long side. Criss Cross resulting strips across the filling.

Lots of other possibilities for fillings , pepperoni , chicken and broccoli,

Bake 30-45 min at 375

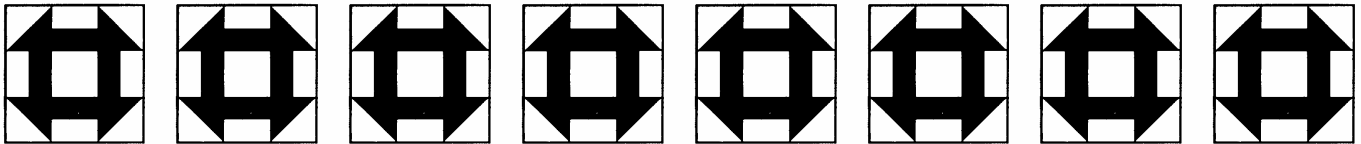
