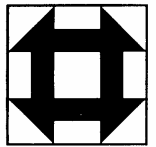

Non-members quilts can be basted for a fee: twin \$25, double \$35, queen \$45, and king \$55. CAN OF WORMS

Buy 1- $\frac{1}{4}$ yards of fabric in the following colors. Wash and iron fabric first, then lay fabric out folded with salvages together. Next, trim both ends even then cut off the salvages and then cut the folded edges. This should yield you two pieces of fabric about 20 to 21 inches wide. The lengths will vary depending on how much of the ends that you had to even up.

July—Yellow 3 inches wide at least 19 inches long—about 30**August—Blue —4 inches****September—Brown —4 inches****October—Rust – 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches****November—Black --2 inches****December—Purple —2 inches****January—Ecru – 3 inches****February—Pink –3 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches****March—Orange –3 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches**

When the width is 3 inches you may cut 1- $\frac{1}{4}$ inches off of one edge to yield you two pieces of fabric, one, of course being 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches wide and the other being 1- $\frac{3}{4}$ inches wide. When the width is 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches you may cut 1 inch off of one edge to yield you two pieces of fabric, one of course being 1 inch and the other being 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches wide. And when the width is 4 inches you may cut off one-edge 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches that will yield you two pieces, one which is 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches wide and the other 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches wide. I will work with four widths, which are 4, 3, 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ and 2 inches. That will yield the sizes ranging from 1-1 $\frac{1}{4}$ - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ - 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ - 2- 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$. You don't have to cut off any edges if you don't want too.

Any color in the color range from light, medium or dark. You may choose solid or prints. The choice is yours. Have fun.

HALL COUNTY QUILT GUILD MINUTES
FOR MAY 1ST 2006

Co/President, Marion Moore, opened the meeting at 10:01 am. The minutes of the April meeting were approved by all. Membership, Carol Nations reported we had 1 new member to join and 1 visitor. Basting Day, Martha Griffin reported that there were no quilts to be basted and to contact Glenda Holcomb or Linda O'Donnell if you have any quilts that need to be basted in the future.

Library, Myra Taylor reported we have a new book "Peel Back Patchwork" by Annette Ornelas who was our guest speaker in April. Eagle Ranch, Jean Leslie reported in July we are going to have an "Eagle Ranch Day" to do kits for boy's quilt tops. Jean would give the date and time to meet later. Jean asked for everyone who was doing a quilt top for Eagle Ranch to please put your name on a piece of paper and pin it to the quilt top if you wanted the quilt to be returned back to you to put the binding on, otherwise no one would know and someone else would do the binding. Jean also asked for more boys' quilts to be made at this time.

June Picnic, Martha Griffin said we need people to sign up for the food list for the picnic and that the picnic would be at her house on June 5th and she would e-mail directions to her home.

2006 Quilt Show, Hertha Hefner reported that the name of the quilt show would be "Birds of a Feather". Hertha said in June she would have entry blanks for everyone to fill out that plan on having a quilt for the show. Hertha said we have the quilt show advertised on the Georgia Quilt Council web site which is www.georgiaquiltcouncil.com.

Jenny Hendrix read a note she received from the Braselton West Jefferson Library thanking us for the donation quilt the guild made them.

Marion Moore reminded everyone about the quilts for the Elderly.

Announcement for Can Of Worms, Glenda Holcomb said she and Joan Cunningham would separate the strips of fabric and hand deliver them back to that person. Glenda gave patterns out to give suggestions as to how to use your can of worms. In June you will need white on white and cut 3" X 42" strips cutting off selvedge and you would need to buy 1 ¼ yards of fabric. Glenda said in August she would do a demo and have sample blocks to show everyone projects to do with your can of worms fabric.

Meeting adjourned at 10:48 am.

The Hall County Quilt Guild Picnic was held June 5 at the home of Martha Griffins on Lake Lanier. The meeting was opened by Ginny and Marion at 11:25. Jean Leslie asked if anyone had taken a red, white and blue quilt, rail fence or log cabin for the binding for Eagle ranch. If you have this quilt please return it as it is not an Eagle Ranch quilt. It was quilted by Richard and belongs to a member. We really need this quilt back as it is unsettling to the owner that she may have lost it...

Hertha gave us guide lines for our quilt show. Quilts are to be in September 1.

No quilts will be accepted without a sleeve. We were encouraged to be willing to help when asked and be ready to serve on a committee.

Glenda will be taking the can of worms colors for June, July, and Aug. any time because she knows summer is a hard time to make all meetings. She will have them all ready divided at the Aug. meeting for us.

Amanda Whitsel showed us an example of a purse we will be making at the Aug. workshop and for us to sign up. At the meeting they will show us there bags and the original pattern and then how to shorten the straps. It will be \$10.

July meeting will be 17th which is our regular basting day but we will be having a short meeting and then cutting fabric for Eagle Ranch quilts. Bring rotary cutters and mats and we will get this done. Yes, we will have raffles and show n tell.

There were 30 people present at our picnic and we had a great time eating the great food we brought. We found out that 4 people volunteer somewhere, two of us have unusual pets or unusual amounts of pets. Four of us lived outside the U.S. for at least a year.

Three have broken a bone recently and 11 of us have had a quilt basted by our guild. Six of us has made a log cabin quilt while only 2 have lime green as there favorite color. 5 of us have seen the Gee's Bend Quilts and 12 have at least 4 grand kids. Six Quilters have visited another country in the last two years. Seven of us are left handed and 9 of us enjoy paperpiecing .Only 4 of us know our

primary and secondary colors but everyone has been to a Ga. Quilted Council meeting this year. Eight of us won an award for a Quilt, while only three entered a quilt in a juried show. There were 5 new members there and 8 executive Committee members there. Three

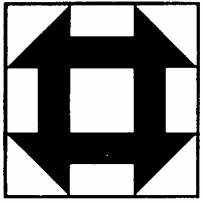

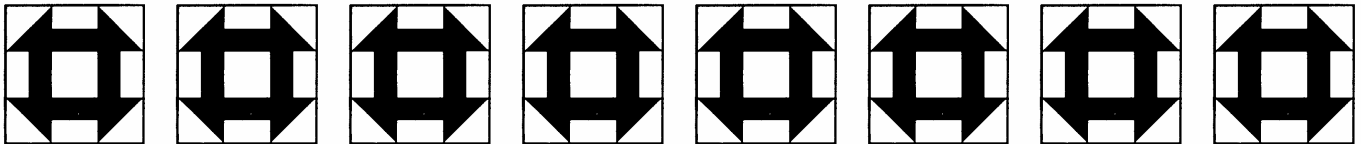
