QUILT TO BE BASTED???

A benefit of being a member of the Hall County Quilt Guild is that your quilts can be basted for free by Guild members. The only requirement is that you participate in basting day, the third Monday of the month, and help baste at least two quilts. Non-members quilts can be basted for a fee: Twin \$25, Double \$35, Queen \$45, or King \$55. Please contact Vice-president Judy Wangemann two weeks in advance if you have a quilt to be basted.

July Program – Shirley Erickson

As you know, we do not have a program for July. Shirley Erickson will be doing a sew-In. You really don't have to bring a sewing machine. It will be on her crayon method. You will need to bring a picture that your child or grandchild has drawn. You could bring a coloring book design. A box of 64 regular crayons, 2 to 4 - 16" squares of muslin and an extra piece of muslin to put on top when you are ironing. You will need a 14" or 16" square of background fabric; you can have more than one, but back with Freezer paper and mechanical pencil, patterns or coloring books. Maybe a small light box if you have one. Also, an iron. You can bring embroidery thread to work on the outline. This is optional. If anyone has an idea for future programs, please see the program chairman.

LOCKER HOOKING WORKSHOP

August 6th, 12 to 3

Come join our locker hooking class. We will make trivet with a heart motif, where you will learn most the techniques of locker hooking. Afterwards you will be able to make rugs, chair pads, pillows, and the best part is that you can use up the "uglies" in your stash. Surprisingly, a rug can take up to 11 yards!

Only color is important as the design of the fabric disappears. It is lots of fun and a wonderful "take along project." I have an "easy on the hands" technique for the borders.

Supply list - Canvas will be provided. (M.C.G. Textiles, 3.75 Graph N' Latch Rug Canvas)

You bring: Locker Hook Tool (local quilt shop or on line www.mcgtexiles.com)

Blunt end tapestry needle #13, Locker hooking twine, Fabric, Gridded ruler, Cutting mat
Scissors (small)

In advance, you may want to cut some strips 1 1/4 inch wide from salvage to salvage. For our border you can cut one inch strips use about 1/4 yard of fabric.

BROCCOLI SALAD

1 large bunch broccoli head, separated into small pieces

1/2 cup chopped Vidalia or red onion

1 cup cherry tomatoes

1 cup of shredded cheddar cheese

1/2 cup slivered almonds

8 slices crisp crumbled bacon

Dressing: 1 cup mayonnaise

1/2 cup sugar

2 tablespoons red wine vinegar

Mix the broccoli onion, almonds and tomatoes together. Just before serving, add the cheddar cheese and bacon and then the dressing.

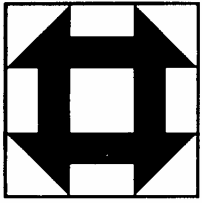

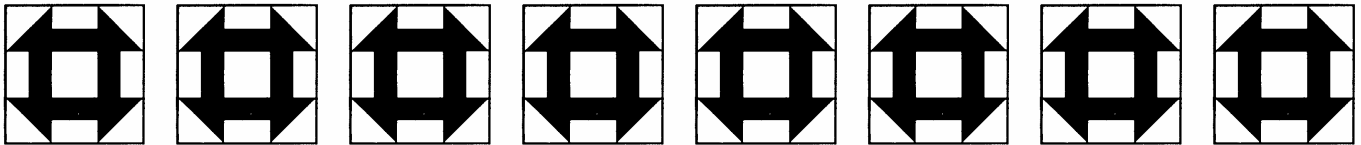
