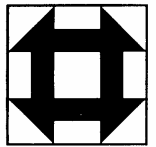

QUILT TO BE BASTED???

A benefit of being a member of the Hall County Quilt Guild is that your quilts can be basted for free by Guild members. The only requirement is that you participate in basting day, the third Monday of the month, and help baste at least two quilts. Non-members quilts can be basted for a fee: twin \$25, double \$35, queen \$45, and king \$55. Please contact vice-president's Glenda Holcomb 770 277-4360 or Linda O'Donnell 770-967-6389 two weeks in advance if you have a quilt to be basted.

## How to get to the Picnic

directions: take I85 north, bear right onto 985 toward Gainsville. Exit 12 at Spout Springs Rd. Turn left under the highway. Proceed to light at railroad crossing. Turn right and take second left across the tracks to deadend at top of hill. Turn right. Cross McEver at light. Road becomes Jim Crow. Take 4th road to your left (Overby). Our house is at the end of this road, 6046 Overby Rd. Turn right at mailboxes onto paved driveway.

## CAN OF WORMS

Buy 1- $\frac{1}{4}$  yards of fabric in the following colors. Wash and iron fabric first, then lay fabric out folded with salvages together. Next, trim both ends even then cut off the salvages and then cut the folded edges. This should yield you two pieces of fabric about 20 to 21 inches wide. The lengths will vary depending on how much of the ends that you had to even up.

**June---White 3 inches wide at least 19 inches long—about 30**

**July—Yellow 3 inches wide at least 19 inches long—about 30**

### **Pieces**

**August—Blue —4 inches**

**September—Brown —4 inches**

**October—Rust – 3  $\frac{1}{4}$  inches**

**November—Black --2 inches**

**December—Purple—2 inches**

**January—Ecru – 3 inches**

**February—Pink –3  $\frac{1}{4}$  inches**

**March—Orange –3  $\frac{1}{4}$  inches**

*When the width is 3 inches you may cut 1- $\frac{1}{4}$  inches off of one edge to yield you two pieces of fabric, one, of course being 1  $\frac{1}{4}$  inches wide and the other being 1- $\frac{3}{4}$  inches wide. When the width is 3  $\frac{1}{4}$  inches you may cut 1 inch off of one edge to yield you two pieces of fabric, one of course being 1 inch and the other being 2  $\frac{1}{4}$  inches wide. And when the width is 4 inches you may cut off one-edge 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches that will yield you two pieces, one which is 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches wide and the other 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches wide. I will work with four widths, which are 4, 3, 3  $\frac{1}{4}$  and 2 inches. That will yield the sizes ranging from 1-1  $\frac{1}{4}$ - 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ - 1  $\frac{3}{4}$ - 2- 2  $\frac{1}{4}$ - 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ . You don't have to cut off any edges if you don't want too.*

Any color in the color range from light, medium or dark. You may choose solid or prints. The choice is yours. Have fun.
