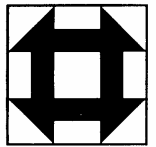

Even so 3,000 women served as Union Army nurses. Dorothea Dix served as the Union's Superintendent of Female Nurses in 1861 without pay.

This talk was enjoyed by all. Thank you, Jayne. I was inspired to make a Civil War quilt. We were reminded that those only age 13 and up are to attend our meetings and any guests are to pay \$2.00.

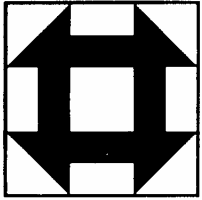

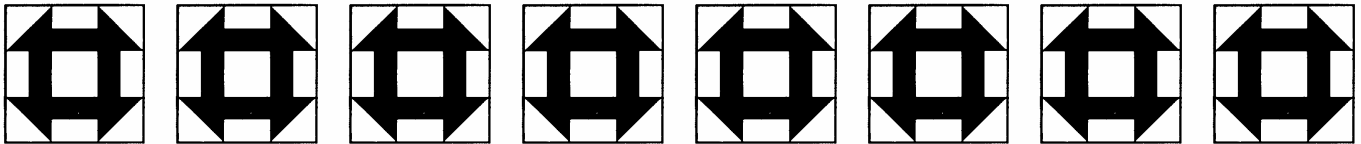
