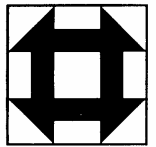

QUILT TO BE BASTED???

A benefit of being a member of the Hall County Quilt Guild is that your quilts can be basted for free by Guild members. The only requirement is that you participate in basting day, the third Monday of the month, and help baste at least two quilts. Non-members quilts can be basted for a fee : Twin \$25, double \$35, queen \$45, and king \$55. CAN OF WORMS

For the month of October the basic color is **RUST**. You will need to 26 strips. FYI-You will have 2 strips left over out of the 1-¼ yard of fabric with the width being 2-1/8 inches wide.

Hi Ladies,

I want to take this time and thank everyone for participating in the swap. Sorry that I have not been up to par. I am going to do my best to keep you more informed. Please keep the following information as a referral when swapping fabric for the worms.

1. Choose one fabric
2. Required amount of fabric is one and one-fourth of a yard.
3. 100% quilt shop quality fabrics please.
4. Wash and iron
5. Cut the salvage off and then the folded edge.
6. Then you cut your strips.
7. Swap only the months that you want too.
8. If you miss a month just pick back up the next month.
9. You can submit strips for future months in advance if you know that you will not be at a meeting. But no make-ups.

The width for September is 4 inches and the base color is **BROWN**. You will end up with 22 strips. Please keep this at 22 pieces of all the same color. You can add as many packages of 22 strips of one color.

I will have the November and December information posted in the October newsletter.

I am truly sorry for any confusion for the months of June, July and August. I will do my best to make the instructions clearer. Please feel free to ask any questions. Also, suggestions of fabric choices are welcome.

Sun Shine, Eliza Cagle, reported that Nancy Folsom is having hip surgery at the Lanier Park Hospital in Gainesville. Will pass around a get well card for everyone to sign for Nancy. Eagle Ranch, Jean Leslie, reported when you complete an Eagle Ranch quilt top please sign the poster provided so we can keep up with how many we do each year. Jean said she has an Eagle Ranch quilt that has been quilted and ready for binding but she doesn't know who it belongs to. If you think it's yours please call or see Jean. Quilt Show News

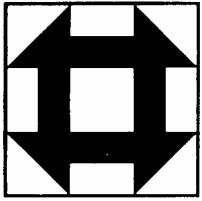

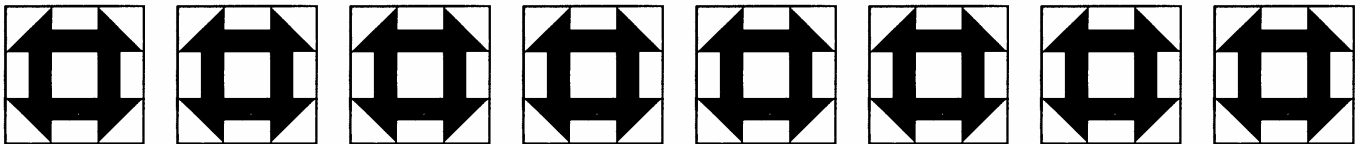
